

It is a general consensus among New Yorkers—even Brooklynites—that Queens is the borough with the widest variety of inexpensive, authentic ethnic food. While Manhattan is packed with trendy eateries, and Brooklyn boasts more than its fair share of ancient culinary institutions, Queens plays host to countless nondescript, simply delicious restaurants catering to the borough's many recent immigrants. For those outsiders lucky enough to find one of these gems of the Queens gastronomic scene, eating becomes an experience less like visiting an outer borough and more akin to visiting a foreign country.

Underneath the elevated 7 train in Jackson Heights, where places like **Jackson Diner** (the city's tastiest Indian) share walls with working class Columbian chicken joints like **Gusty Chicken**, it is difficult to find an overpriced meal and nearly impossible to find a burger and fries. In Elmhurst, nestled amongst a strip

of mysteriously named ethnic restaurants, startlingly delectable Malaysian cuisine at **Taste Good** sits beneath an awning that reads "Chinese Noodles." Even Astoria, a neighborhood known city-wide for the more traditional Greek fare it provides at spots like **Stamatis**, serves up scrumptious Middle-Eastern and North African eat at eateries along Steinway Street such as **Mombar** and **Kabab Café**.

Of course, if you so desire, you can find an excellent steak in one of Queens' old school neighborhoods—try **Uncle Jack's Steakhouse** in Bayside. But Queens is truly unique for its ethnic fare, so take a trip to Flushing next time you're in the mood for beef. Visit **San Hai Jin Mi**, and chow down on delightful Korean *bulgogi* BBQed at your table any time of the day or night. It may seem like a trek, but its nothing compared to a flight to Seoul.
